What we are learning in school:

Maths:

- Multiplication fact families and applying the inverse
- Written methods for multiplication and division
- Problem solving
- Fractions, including finding fractions of an amount, adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator.

English:

- Hermelin A whole school focus on one book to celebrate World Book Day.
- Jabari Jumps; Ralph Tells a Story The Proudest Blue looking at writing s personal narrative or memoir
- Love that Dog—Poetry looking at calligrams and free verse

Reading:

The children will have daily guided reading sessions exploring the 6 key skills, represented by the acronym VIPERS.

- Vocabulary,
- Inference,
- Prediction
- Explanation
- Retrieval
- Summarising.

We will be looking at a variety of different texts both in our whole class reading times as well as reading books together as a class.



What we are learning in school:

<u>History:</u> 'The Celts/Iron Age' - We will explore when the Bronze Age was and how it links to the Iron Age. We will explore life for a child during this time and the different occupations and beliefs the people held.

<u>Design and Technology:</u> 'British Inventors' - We will explore different British inventors and how their inventions have changed the world and life as we know it as well as how effective they were and how we would change it.

<u>Science:</u> 'British Science Week' - To celebrate science week we will explore jobs that scientist do and participate in a range of activities focussing on the difference types of enquiry skills and look at.

RE: 'How do festivals and family life show what matters to Jewish people' - We will build on our knowledge about Jewish worldviews and way of life. We will recap work on Shabbat and deepen understanding by considering how different Jews today mark it. We will explore Shabbat, Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, and Pesach to build up understanding of festivals and ideas of forgiveness, remembering, and freedom.

PE: 'Witches and Wizards' - We will be focussing on our rhythmical understanding and use of space and tempo of the music to tell a story.

French: 'Fruits and Vegetables' - We will be able to name and recognise 10 different fruits in French whilst developing our understanding of French articles/determiners.

<u>Music:</u> 'The children are continuing with their recorder lessons and developing the skill of reading music and performing.

<u>Computing:</u> 'We Are Who We Are'. We will be creating presentations about our earliest memories, our hobbies and interests whilst developing our PowerPoint skills.

PSHE: 'Healthy Me' - We will explore how our bodies are complex and need taking care of through diet and exercise. We will discuss feeling safe and unsafe and what we can do.
