1. Introduction

The school expects all children to wear school uniform, look neat and tidy and take pride in their appearance. Parents and Carers are asked to support the school's uniform policy by providing the correct uniform. We request that you label all items of clothing with your child's name.

2. Our Uniform

Our school uniform consists of the following items:

- White Polo Shirt or white shirt
- Purple cardigan, sweatshirt, or jumper with or without the school logo on it
- Grey or black skirt or pinafore dress
- Purple and White gingham dress
- Grey or black trousers
- Grey or black knee length shorts
- Grey, black, or white socks or tights
- Black shoes – these can be proper shoes or plain black trainers. No sandals, heeled shoes or crocs.

3. PE Kit

For the days when a pupil has PE, the uniform can be changed for PE kit as follows:

- Purple PE T shirt (school logo optional)
- Black shorts which are suitable for school including in length (no hot pants).
- Trainers
- Black jogging bottoms or plain black leggings
- Purple PE hooded top (optional) or school jumper/cardigan

4. Optional Uniform items

- Book bags
- PE bags
- Sun hats
- Winter hats
- Scarves

5. OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning)

We strive to spend every day outside at lunch time and therefore ask that children have a pair of wellies, which they can store in their class wellie shed. In addition, during cold wet months, children may want to bring in waterproofs and/or a spare set of uniform.

6. Jewellery

Apart from one pair of stud earrings (one earring in each ear), no other jewellery should be worn.

The pupil must be able to remove and/or tape over the earring for PE lessons. The school does not take any responsibility for keeping removed jewellery safe.

A watch may be worn as long as it does not have the ability to take calls, photographs, or videos (no Smart watches). The school does not take any responsibility for keeping removed watches safe.

6. Hair and Make Up

For health and safety reasons all hair that is shoulder length or longer must be tied back (boys included). Nail varnish and make up should not be worn at school.
